The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Windle Hardy, Mike Lennier, and Jack Porter.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Windle Hardy, Mike Lennier, and Jack Porter.

Discussion with city managers, mayors, and fire chiefs of Grady County on the sales tax for the fire departments: Mr. Hardy welcomed the mayors, city managers, and fire chiefs and opened the discussion pertaining to the issue of the sales tax for fire departments:

Chickasha City Manager, Stewart Fairburn stated his concerns with sales tax reaching 9 to 10% makes it hard to renew the sales tax, cities need sales tax to survive or when it becomes necessary for a sales tax it would make it harder to sell to the public for approval. Mr. Fairburn stated he really needed more information about the sales tax request and all that it involves. Tuttle City Manager, Tim Young agreed and expressed concern and the need for more clarification also. Tuttle Mayor, Bobby Williams agreed stating more information is necessary and expressed concern on getting the sales tax approved. The Verden Fire Chief encouraged a meeting with all involved to explain the needs of the fire departments and getting everyone on the same page pertaining to the funds and Blanchard Fire Chief stated that he didn't oppose, but also wanted more information. Grady County Fire Chief, Perry Wenzel stated that the sales tax is the only fair tax and all fire departments help when fires happen and a meeting with all involved is absolutely necessary. Mike Lennier agreed and stated with the county helping the county fire stations is becoming more difficult since the gross production tax has been reduced and funding is not as much as in the past and this is a concern because of the needs of the fire departments. The board requested that all of the city managers, mayors, and fire chiefs meet and discuss and return to the board with more information.
