

MINUTES OF THE GRADY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING HELD ON MARCH 14, 2016

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Mike Lennier, Windle Hardy, and Ralph Beard.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Mike Lennier, Windle Hardy, and Ralph Beard.

Windle Hardy made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 7, 2016 meeting. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Mike Lennier, AYE: Windle Hardy, and AYE: Ralph Beard.

Mike Lennier made a motion to approve the following blanket purchase order numbers 164072 to 164081 & 164083 to 164085. It was seconded by Windle Hardy. AYE: Mike Lennier, AYE: Windle Hardy, and AYE: Ralph Beard.

GCEMA/Fire Report: Dale Thompson informed the board that the second half of the EMS class is this week. Mr. Thompson submitted a brochure from Hyper-Reach Emergency Notification Program-Standard Notification System with Reach targeting for storm warnings, road closings etc. The program is \$14,000 a year and the board will investigate further. Fire report: Assistant Fire Chief, Buddy Myers stated the volunteers have finished their class, will be doing emergency vehicle training, and CPR training. There were 34 calls-hazard mat, 18 medical calls, and 1 structure fire-(vehicle).

There was no update from the Safety Progress.

There was no action on the plat of Harvest Moon-SE/4 of Section 31-T8N-R7W.

Windle Hardy made a motion to accept the applications for permits from Enable Gas Gathering LLC, permits to cross with a gas pipeline, a county road or highway-Cross County Road EW1365 between the NW/4 of Section 31-T7N-R6W and the SW/4 of Section of Section 31-T7N-R6W-further described as 2626' North & 1115' East of the SW corner of Section 31-T7N-R6W. Windle Hardy made a motion to accept the applications for permits from Enable Gas Gathering LLC, permits to cross with a gas pipeline, a county road or highway-Cross County Road N 2870 between the NE/4 of Section 36-T7N-R7W & the NW/4 of Section 31-T7N-R6W-further described as 2598' South of the NE corner of Section 36-T7N-R7W. Windle Hardy made a motion to accept the applications for permits from Charter Oak Production, Co.- permits to cross with a road bore, a county road or highway-County Line Road between Section 12-T9N-R5W & Section 7-T9N-R4W-(Not Grady County). Presentation by GEOFF Covalt with CEC on GIS Geographic Information System:
