MINUTES OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING HELD ON SEPTEMBER 28, 2020

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 21, 2020 meeting. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter and Abstain: Mike Walker.

Dale Thompson spoke to the board about the status of COVID-19 in regards of the threat to Grady County public safety COVID-19 (Coronavirus) posed. He reported to the board that as of Sunday there are 1,076 cases and 11 deaths in Grady County. Dale stated that he has been notified that Grady County's Status is now in the red, however he has been unable to verify this information. The Board wanted Dale to look into the temperature reading for the Courthouse Security Vestibule.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale also informed the Board that he had been working on the Cares Act Reimbursement forms. He also had a question about a reimbursement he had received from Amazon. Kim Duke informed the Board that there was a Chief meeting Monday night, she also had PO requests. Bobby Cantu reported to the board that there were no reportable injuries. K&M Safety Solutions had completed the annual fire extinguisher inspection for District 1 and completed the Corporation Commission fuel leak tank inspections for all three barns. He informed the board that he has a safety talk scheduled for the Security Vestibule. He stated that he would be out on N2862 and County Road 1380 for GPS coordinates and to take pictures for FEMA. Finally, he stated that the Radon level in the basement of the Courthouse was 1.23 which was within the safe rage being below 4.0.

No draw request for Grady Memorial Hospital.

The Commissioners requested to put on next week agenda to go out for bid for the parking lot for Grady Memorial Hospital.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve the bid request for a paved parking lot in front of the new Jail. Jim Gerlach, with the Grady County Criminal Justice Authority, and Richard Starks, an architect, were in attendance and provided information about the parking lot and requirements.
