MINUTES OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MEETING HELD ON OCTOBER 26, 2020

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 19, 2020 meeting. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve the amendment of 10 to 14-day quarantine to the Grady County's Covid Policy. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Dale Thompson spoke to the board about the status of COVID-19 in regards of the threat to Grady County public safety COVID-19 (Coronavirus) posed. He stated that the portable ozone machines can have long term health effects to individuals so he felt that the spraying was more effective. He also stated that he had looked into the charcoal filters for the face masks. Dale reported to the Commissioners that the County had submitted 1.1 million dollars for the Cares Act and the deadline for submissions to the Cares Act was still November 1, 2020.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale informed the board he was still working on the Cares Act to get everything in before the deadline. He also stated that the County was in an Ice Storm warning. He informed the board that PSO had been already getting prepared ahead of time for the storm. Kim Duke stated that there is a Fire Board meeting last Tuesday. In the Chief report they stated that they wanted to get the Harold station a new brush truck. Bobby Cantu reported that the County had no reportable injuries last week. Bobby stated he had completed the Safety meeting for District 2, he also completed the monthly Corporation Commission fuel leak tank inspections for all 3 districts, and the monthly Fire Extinguisher inspection at the Fairgrounds. Bobby told the board that the Gregory Road Bridge Project #121157 has been obligated for funding in the amount of \$31,360.68 for District 1. He also stated that he will be completing the annual fire extinguisher inspection for all of Grady County Facilities next week. He has also gotten ahold of Heritage Hills Commercial Roofing to put up the safety cage around the ladder at the EM and Election Board Complex. Finally, he stated that he had assisted with a vehicle rollover early Saturday morning.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the reorganization plan for the Grady County Complex. It will require minimal construction to the building, about \$3,500 to hook the Generator up to the whole building, and \$1,580 to move the antennas. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

No draw request for Grady Memorial Hospital.

Ralph Beard made a motion to forward the tort claim claim to ACCO. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve the bid for the paved parking lot in front of the new jail in the amount of \$115,730.00, including concrete, to the Cotner. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve the written quotes for carpet and tile in Courtroom One (Judge Kirkland's Courtroom) in the amount of \$13,249.12 to the All American. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Mike Walker made a motion, after discussion and looking at the best way to get the Conservation District moved, for the highest amount the Board of Grady County Commissioners would approve the Fairgrounds to pay the Conservation District the amount of \$475,000.00.
