Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on April 26, 2021

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kim Duke told the board that the Fire Chief's meeting was Monday night and that they would be doing more ISO testing this week. She also had PO requests. Bobby Cantu informed the Commissioners that there were no reportable injuries last week. He reported that the monthly Corporation Commission Fuel Tank Inspections for all 3 district barns and the monthly Fire Extinguisher inspection for all county facilities are completed.
