

Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on February 7, 2022

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for an regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 31, 2022 meeting. It was seconded by Mike Walker. Abstain: Ralph Beard, AYE: Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale Thompson informed the Board that the snow storm totals were from 3 to 7 inches in Grady County. He stated that the Election Board had heater issues last week but had them resolved on Friday. Kim Duke had requisition requests and told the Commissioners that the Fire Board meeting would be next Tuesday. Bobby Cantu reported that he went out on a single vehicle roll-over accident last week. Bobby informed the Commissioners that they cut out the beds in the old jail when the Courthouse was closed for the bad weather. Bobby stated that on Sunday he was at a Grady County Fire Department training at Naples and he will be conducting the first quarterly safety meetings with the Treasurer, County Clerk, and Emergency Management offices.

Kirk Painter made a motion to remove the burn ban for Grady County that was issued December 27, 2021. He stated that everyone who needs to do a controlled burn needs to call the Sheriff's office and report it first. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Dale Thompson stated that we have 698 cases of COVID in Grady County, that number is down 42.9%. There have been 8 new hospitalizations in the County. Mr. Spellman stated that the immunizations for COVID are low and the data is not reliable on how many cases there are because people are not getting tested.

Ralph Beard informed the Board that he had spoken with the hospital and with David Floyd about the new request from the hospital for Capital Projects. He stated that the Resurrection House grant had been denied, they were hoping for half of the money from a grant and the other half would come from the ARPA money, but since this did not happen, they said for now they would not need the ARPA money. Commissioner Beard stated that the ARPA funds are at 3 million right now so he would like to see the County accept the hospital's application.

Ralph Beard made a motion to accept the application to use American Rescue Plan Money to fund Grady Memorial Hospital Capital Expenditures, the hospital is requesting 1.48 million. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

No draw request from the Grady Memorial Hospital.

The Board recognized Ms. Daryn Kirkpatrick as the new Regional Administrative Director for the Grady County Health Department.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve the tabled item for removing Jackie Kanak as Requisitioning Officer for the Health Department and adding Daryn Kirkpatrick. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.
