## Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on October 18, 2021

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for an regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Mike Walker made a motion to approve the minutes of the October 12, 2021 regular meeting. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale Thompson informed the Commissioners that on Thursday October 21, 2021, he will be at the Great American Shake Out Earthquake Drill, Tuesday he will be attending Mitigation training over weather, it will be held online. Dale told the Board he was contacted by David McQuade about a drill that Tagra Resources wants to host in November. He would like to see as many people as possible get involved with this. Dale asked Ralph Beard if he could get his crew to cut down some tree limbs at the Repeater site in Rush Springs. Dale informed the Board about a class that Amanda Wilkerson and a volunteer will be taking online Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday this week. Bobby Cantu was in attendance and reported to the Board that Grady County had no reportable injuries last week. Bobby stated that he would be conducting the monthly safety meeting with District #2 this week, the monthly Corporation Commission Fuel Leak Tank Inspection for all three county barns, and the monthly extinguisher inspection for all our county facilities. Bobby updated the Commissioners on the status of the Courthouse Jail windows; to have proper ventilation they had to remove mesh and plexiglass.

Dale Thompson reported to the Board that the State updated the list of Covid cases and there are 7,911 total case, 140 active cases, and 156 deaths in Grady County.

No update on the American Rescue Plan Act Money.

No draw request from the Grady Memorial Hospital.

Mike Walker made a motion to award the quoted bids for new flooring in Judge Lowe's Courtroom (Courtroom 2) to Carpet Masters in the amount of \$10,428.29.
