## Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on September 20, 2021

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for an regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Mike Walker made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 13, 2021 regular meeting. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

Mike Walker made a motion to approve the amended plat map called Red Rock Creek Estates. The plat was accepted with no maintenance to the road. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale Thompson informed the Commissioners that he is working on a Walmart grant and the REAP grant this week. Kim Duke stated that the Fire Board meeting is Tuesday night. Bobby Cantu reported that Grady County had one reportable accident last week. Bobby stated that he is working on the annual fire extinguisher inspections and the monthly Corporation Commission fuel leak tank inspections. Bobby updated the Board on H & H Plumbing for the work on the sewer system, he said that the work was almost finished, the Courtroom sewer issue has been looked into and resolved. Bobby reported that he had one vehicle accident this morning.

Dale Thompson reported to the Board that there are 346 active COVID cases and 161 total deaths in Grady County. There has been a 15.1% decrease in Covid cases.

Mr. Spellman spoke to the Board to request a portion of the American Rescue Plan Act Funds. He submitted a request for funding for recruitment bonus payment to short term public health workers in the amount of \$475,200.00 and supplemental staff payroll support in the amount of \$903,500.00. Mr. Spellman stated that currently staffing assistance is the hospital's biggest need as they have lost nurses and staff to larger hospitals. Mr. Spellman also stated that they have been operating in the red since Covid hit and they would request revenue loss funding at a later date. Ralph Beard stated that he had been in contact with David Floyd, the County's Lawyer for the ARPA money, and David stated that the current requests from the hospital qualified. Ralph then called Mr. Floyd and put him on speaker phone for the Board and audience. Mr. Floyd stated that the hospital had submitted two proposals; the first was an incentive bonus with six-month contracts, the second is for payroll support. Mr. Floyd stated that both requests are both appropriate request's and recommended the following suggestions on moving forward; upon the Boards approval for the Hospitals ARPA Funding, the entire amount will be encumbered for both types of requests, for the contract employment we will not expend any of the funds until the employee is hired and the contracts are signed, for the retention of employees the money can be expended once the hospital submits a letter and status update of the employees who have received the incentive in time increments of 30 days, 60 days, and 6 months. Ralph asked if Mr. Spellman understood the process. Mr. Spellman stated that receiving the money upfront would be easier for the hospital, as they would not have the reserves to float the money. Mr. Floyd stated that he

understood what Mr. Spellman was saying however, if we encumber and wait to expend the money, we would be safe is something went wrong and the hospital was unable to use a portion of the money, the county would not have to worry about trying to recoup the money. Also, he stated that would help with reporting purposes and the County would be able to continue to draw interest on the money until it was expended. The Board thanked Mr. Floyd for his help and the phone conference ended. Mr. Spellman stated not receiving the money all at once could cause major issues for the hospital. Ralph stated that he understood, but felt that he wanted to follow Mr. Floyd's advice because of his knowledge on the subject. Kirk Painter stated as soon as the contracts are signed, we can expend the money, then he asked Charles if he had any questions. Charles stated that the Commissioner's needed to have a vote and decide how the money was to be paid; if the Commissioners were going to vote on each contract or does the one vote approve all of the payments. Mike Walker asked why we wouldn't just pay it all at once. Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the money for the hospital because we need these nurses quickly. Mike Walker then asked how are we going to expended the money. Kirk stated that he didn't see a problem with giving the hospital all of the money at once. Kirk asked Charles if he seen a problem with paying the money all at once to the hospital. Charles stated that he didn't see a problem with it, that it would prevent the need to have the hospital come to the Board with multiple requests. Ralph then stated that he didn't want to go against their legal counsel as they hired David Floyd as our legal counsel on this. Kirk stated that David Floyd is not our legal counsel he is our advisor. Mike stated that Charles was their legal counsel and he said it was ok. Kirk Painter then amended his original motion as follows: to approve the request for American Rescue Plan Act money from the hospital and to give it to them now. Mike Walker seconded. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

No draw request from the Grady Memorial Hospital.

Mike Walker made a motion to approve the engagement letter from the Oklahoma State Auditor County Audit for the 2019-2020 County Audit. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

Ralph Beard made a motion to table an interlocal agreement with the City of Chickasha to redo Pikes Peak Road. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve of a resolution to select the CEC Corporation as consulting engineer for the Winter Creek Project known as CO BR (NS-294) over Winter Creek, 6.0 miles east & 3.2 miles south of JCT SH-39/SH-76 (P.E.FOR 3354404) in accordance with the terms and tenor of 69 O.S. 2001, Section 601. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.

Mike Walker made a motion to approve the utility/pipeline road crossing permits, waterline/fast-line permits, and driveway/tinhorn permits for District #1. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Mike Walker, Kirk Painter, and Ralph Beard.
