Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on April 18, 2022

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for an regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter. Mike Walker was absent.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter. Mike Walker was absent.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2022 Special meeting. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Emergency Management was absent. Kim Duke reported they have had a lot of fires and the Fire Board meeting is Tuesday night, April 19, 2022. Kim had requisition requests. Commissioner Beard stated he felt that getting Kim Duke a part-time employee would be helpful and would like to address it in the next meeting. Stormy Duffle was in attendance and wanted to let the Commissioners know that there was a fire in Bradley on Sunday, and they were denied water by the Bradley Water Department. Commissioner Beard said he knew of the situation and would be addressing it. Bobby Cantu reported to the Commissioners that he would be doing the monthly Safety meeting with District #2 this week; as well as, the monthly fire extinguisher and Corporation Commission Fuel Leak Tank inspections for all 3 district barns and county facilities. Bobby said that he is preparing a Safety Data Sheet book for our combined Emergency Management, Election Board, and Fire Administrator building. He gave a report on the Land Records room leak; he informed the Board that he could try a few things to help with this since the rainy season could become an issue. The company in charge of fixing the problem cannot get the parts they need to finish the project.

Commissioner Beard has spoken to David Floyd, the consultant for the American Rescue Plan Act money, and Mr. Floyd informed the Commissioner that he had finished the ARPA quarterly reports and he would check with the County Clerk's office to make sure everything went through. Mr. Floyd reported that there had been several applications that had been turned in and they would be looking at them to see what qualified.

Ralph Beard made a motion to take action on authorizing and approving a resolution approving and authorizing the election of the standard allowance for revenue replacement for the County from American Rescue Plan Act ("ARPA") Funds; requiring record retention; and declaring an emergency. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

No draw request from Grady Memorial Hospital.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve to replace Jack Porter on the Washita Valley Community Action Council with Kirk Painter. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the five-year Exemption Reimbursement for Grady County Assessor. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve of the Grady County projects in the CIRB five-year plan. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve All American Home Center to complete the flooring in Courtroom #2 for \$8,582.00 pending proof of insurance and bonding. Commissioner Beard said that Judge Lowe wants the tile that was put in her office removed. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve a lease agreement between Grady County and Norman Regional Hospital Authority for the property located at 205 W. Chickasha Ave., Chickasha, OK for rental of office space. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve erecting a sign stating "Commercial trucks in excess of 3 axles prohibited" located in District #1 from Fox Lane to Highway 4. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Ralph Beard made a motion to recess to sign the 2020 and 2021 Audit Report from the Auditors. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Ralph Beard made a motion to return to the meeting. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.

Audience Participation: Ms. Maretta Rogers was present and asked the Board how to be appointed to the Fire Board. The Commissioners responded in saying that you would have to apply with the Fire Board and after they have accepted someone, they bring it to the Commissioners and then it is approved by them. The only person that is paid is Kim Duke the Fire Department Administrative Secretary, and she is paid out of the County Highway fund. Ms. Rogers asked if Mr. Painter saw the Washita Valley Shopper, he replied yes and explained what happened with the barn which was originally at District 1, but is no longer in that district. Ms. Rogers asked Commissioner Beard if he was still planning on visiting with her about her issues with her road. Mr. Beard stated yes, as soon as he could he was going to pay her a visit and look at her issues.

Zac Davis was present and asked the Board what the policy and procedures are in regards to the Open Records Act. He said he would like to look at Appropriations, Time Sheets, Payroll, and Purchase Orders. Mr. Davis was told that county records are open to the public with an open record request form in the County Clerk's office; social security and payroll deductions could not be given, but everything else is open.

New Business: Commissioner Beard told the Board that the new Health Department building needs 15 new air conditioners and the estimate he got was over \$156,000.00. He said we would need to bid these air conditioners and asked to put them on the agenda next week. Commissioner Beard received a letter from the CEC about who is responsible for the load posting signs for bridges within the County, and would like to put this on the agenda to speak to all the Commissioners on how they wanted to handle this issue. Bobby Cantu gave the Commissioners the estimate for the parking lot maintenance at the Courthouse; the Commissioners decided to put it on the agenda next week to approve.

Ralph Beard made a motion to adjourn. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard and Kirk Painter.
