

## **Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on March 28, 2022**

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for an regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker. Ralph Beard was absent.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2022 regular meeting. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 24, 2022 emergency meeting. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale Thompson told the Board that after the brief power outage on Wednesday, he has contacted a company to give an estimate on what a generator would cost for the courthouse to run the computers and telephones. Dale reported that there is a chance of severe weather and that Amanda is at the Emergency Management State Conference this week. Kim Duke reported that the Special Grady County Fire Board meeting was held last Friday and she would be getting the minutes ready from that meeting today. Kim had blanket requisition requests. Bobby Cantu informed the Board that Grady County had one reportable motor vehicle accident last week. He brought to the Board the estimate from Chris Brown Plumbing for the building located on 205 West Chickasha Avenue. Bobby stated that he would be conducting the monthly Corporation Commission Fuel Leak Tank Inspections, the monthly Fire Extinguisher inspections and would be attending the spring ACCO meeting this week. Bobby gave an update on the jail, he let the Commissioners know that they were ready to start painting. He informed Commissioner Painter that he had to use a barricade from District 2 to put up on County Road 1220.

Kirk Painter made a motion to remove the burn ban for Grady County and readdress on April 4, 2022. The Commissioners will put it back on the agenda on Monday April 4, 2022. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Commissioner Painter stated that there were no updates from David Floyd on the Premium Pay for the employees. He was attending a meeting on Monday night with Rural Water District 6 about the ARPA funds and Pocasset and Friend Fire Stations needing to get new fire extinguishers and would like to see if they could apply for ARPA money also.

No draw request from Grady Memorial Hospital.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve a lease agreement between Grady County and South-Central Oklahoma Workforce Board for office space located at 205 West Chickasha Avenue. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

**Kirk Painter made a motion to accept the bid for asbestos removal for Chickasha Senior Nutrition Center Building from Crystal Creek, LLC for \$34,150.00. The other bidder was Tec-An Inc. placed a bid of \$34,500.00. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.**

**Kirk Painter made a motion to table the rebid of Asphalts for District 3 – Hot Mix Cold Lay, Vinsonite or Equivalent, Type A, B, and C Hot Mix. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter and Mke Walker.**

The Commissioners read a letter from the State Auditor's Office explaining how the auditors would only audit the Sales Tax money for the Fire Board. Kirk Painter made a motion to table a County Audit of the Grady County Fire Department Board and its twelve stations. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

Kirk Painter made a motion to add Jeff Sifers as a requisitioning officer for the District Attorney's Requisitioning Department. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.

**Bruce Anthony, Major Martinez, Conrad Martinez and Chris Dunn asked the Commissioners for help in getting access to their land. They said there is a gate that is locked and prevents 8 residents accessing it. They asked if the road had been closed, the Commissioners said they have not closed County Road 1439. They stated Commissioner Beard said that he had been given proof that there was access to the land by the residents, however this was not true and they wanted this issue resolved. The Board told them to get in touch with Commissioner Beard on this matter.**

**Jeff Tyler asked the Board if there was any interest in providing an ATM machine for the public. He said he felt it would be beneficial to citizens of Grady County who don't have cash or checks.**

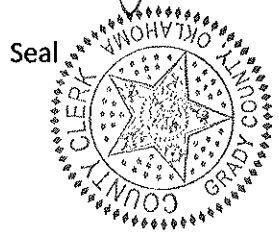
Kirk Painter made a motion to adjourn. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Kirk Painter and Mike Walker.
