Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on December 5, 2022

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve the minutes of the November 28, 2022 regular meeting. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Mike Walker made a motion to approve an engagement letter for the County Officer Turnover Statutory Report between the Oklahoma State Auditor's Office and Grady County Commissioner, District One. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale Thompson informed the Commissioners that he was working on setting up a two-day Public Assistance Training in March at the Vo-tech. The training would consist of the basics of public assistance and he stated that he invited the municipalities and all the local Emergency Managers in the County. Dale told the Board he had a state training committee meeting this coming Friday. Dale had been in contact with the District Attorney about if any of the County Employees had their Hazmat training. He said it was a 40-hour long training and was sure that the County Employees did not have this training. Dale informed the Commissioners we should have good weather this week with a good chance of rain. Kim Duke stated that the Special Fire Board meeting was cancelled due to no quorum. December 18th is the next scheduled regular meeting. Bobby Cantu had nothing new to report.

No draw request from the Grady Memorial Hospital.

Angela Jones, attorney representing the Grady County Home Finance Authority was in attendance and spoke on the authority's behalf. Mrs. Jones informed the Board that today they would like to present a check for \$236,000.00 to Grady County. She stated the final account balance is \$256,360.21 but they have to do an end of the year audit and in order for them to pay for the audit, they are holding a little over \$20,000.00. At the end of next year, they will be doing a final affidavit report and final balance will then be disbursed to the County.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve terminating the Grady County Home Finance Authority Trust & distributing the funds to the beneficiary (Board of County Commissioners of Grady County) and to deposit the money into the General Fund. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

ARPA Discussion: Commissioner Painter told the Board that after speaking with the attorneys from Floyd and Driver he would like for everyone to get their applications in because the money is going to go fast.

Kirk Painter made a motion of awarding ARPA Funds to Grady Memorial Hospital, Grady County for general governmental services projects, specifically for the remodel of the Emergency Department at Grady Memorial Hospital in an amount not to exceed \$279,000. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Kirk Painter made a motion of awarding ARPA Funds to Grady Memorial Hospital, Grady County for general governmental services projects, specifically for the acquisition and installation of a fire control sprinkler system in the IT server room at Grady Memorial Hospital in an amount not to exceed \$30,000. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Kirk Painter made a motion of awarding ARPA Funds to Grady Memorial Hospital, Grady County for general governmental services projects, specifically for the acquisition and installation of a water-based sprinkler add-on system in the radiology area at Grady Memorial Hospital in an amount not to exceed \$80,000. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Commissioner Beard addressed Mr. Spellman and asked a question about starting the OB/GYN program. Mr. Spellman explained that the OB/GYN renovation could be over 6 million dollars and at this time they would have to seek funding for this project. He does have lenders that would be willing to lend half of the amount but does not think that things are that stable in the economy at this time. He stated that he has some physicians coming in and is excited to have them. He has no Covid issues at this time but RSV has really ramped up.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve creating the Opioid Abatement Settlement Fund (1251). It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve creating the Opioid Abatement Settlement Fund M&O Account (1251-1-2000-2005) and setting the General Department as the Requisitioning/Receiving Department. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Kirk Painter made a motion to appoint William Schwenk as the Central District Trustee for the Grady County EMS District Board to finish out the term left vacant by the passing of Guy Huggins. It was seconded by Ralph Beard. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Kirk Painter made a motion to table re-appointing Jerry White to the Equalization/Excise Board for the term beginning January 1, 2023; Commissioner Painter is wanting to look at other candidates. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Commissioner Painter stated that the allocations from highway money are District #1-33%, District #2 - 30%, and District #3 - 37%. He is proposing that they reallocate to District #1 - 32%, District #2 - 32%, and District #3 - 36% because of the redistricting and the road miles that were changed in each district. Mr. Sifers stated because of Title 19 section 333, he would like a chance to review this information before a vote is taken.

Kirk Painter made a motion to table the following division of road money for Districts 1, 2, and 3. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve depositing a check from ACCO in the amount of \$4,696.45 into the Sheriff Service M&O Account (1226-2-0400-2005) for cost of repairs to a sheriff's vehicle from incident that occurred November 16, 2022. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.

Ralph Beard made a motion to approve the utility/pipeline road crossing permits, waterline/fast-line permits, and driveway/tinhorn permits for District #2. It was seconded by Mike Walker. AYE: Ralph Beard, Kirk Painter, and Mike Walker.
