Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the county officer monthly reports for the Health Dept. and the Court Clerk. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the estimate of needs, request for appropriations, transfer of appropriations for County Highway, and Rural Fire – Sales Tax. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Audience Participation: Maretta Rogers was in attendance to speak with the Commissioners about property that the County owns, that used to be owned by her family.

Officials Quarterly Meeting: The Elected Officials that were present: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, Zac Davis, Bari Firestone, Lisa Hannah, Robin Burton, Jill Locke, and Jim Weir. Others included Ruth Bingham, and Sydney Richardson. Commissioner Painter opened with reading the SA&I Internal Controls, the discussion directly related to Control Environment. Jill Locke passed out hand-outs to talk about. Commissioner Painter then asked her to speak on the hand-outs. Ms. Locke informed the Officials that there has been discussion on how sick leave was being taken care of and would like to know if the way it has been done made sense. Our current sick leave policy seems to punish the employees who come to work every day and allow their sick leave to build, in case they have an emergency. Currently, once they reach their maximum limit, they do not accrue anymore sick leave. As the County does not pay sick leave out to an employee at the end of employment, this will not harm the County, only allow for emergency situations employees may have. The County Clerk's Office did contact ACCO about the accumulation limit and ACCO stated that the State does not have a limit and it is not required. All of the Officials agreed and wanted to remove the accumulation limit on the sick leave accrual. The next item was the vacation accrual. There was discussion on changing the accrual method from once a year, to a monthly basis. This would prevent new employees from having to wait one year to receive their 2-week vacation. The Officials said that they would like more information on this before making that decision. Ms. Locke gave the Officials information on changing the percentage raises to a matrix type system for raises. This was discussed during budget time and needs to be addressed. The Officials said they would look at this system and see if they would be willing to do this. Finally, Ms. Locke addressed the problem that purchasing is having with Purchase Orders not being opened before items are being purchased. The new Commissioners want this addressed with all the Officials and to make sure that it is clear to everyone a Purchase Order cannot be paid with a "made-up" invoice or statement.

Kirk Painter made a motion to adjourn. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.
