No County Officer monthly reports.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the estimate of needs, request for appropriations, transfer of appropriations for County Highway. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

New Business: Sheriff Boggess introduced his new Undersheriff, Kori Brewer to the Board of Commissioners and invited them to a formal ceremony on February 28, 2023.

Kim Thomas-Smith spoke with the Board about a County Easement from 1918. The land owners wanted to know if the County would be willing to turn it into a Public Easement.

Officials Meeting: Chairman Kirk Painter, Vice Chairman Gary Bray, Commissioner Zachary Davis, County Clerk-Jill Locke, Assessor-Bari Firestone, Sheriff-Gary Boggess, Court Clerk-Lisa Hannah, and Ruth Bingham-Treasurer 1st deputy. Kealee Romero-County Clerk 1st Deputy was present to speak with the Officials changing the policy we currently have for vacation to a vacation accrual policy. Kealee stated that currently an employee must wait one full year before they receive any vacation time off, then it is switched to accrue on January 1st. She explained the monthly accrual would be earned at the same time the sick leave is accrued. Also, the vacation time would not have to be used by December, it would have a maximum accrual amount and once that amount is received the employee would stop accruing until they used some of their vacation time. Another option is to not pay all the vacation out when an employee terminates with Grady County. It was suggested that we put a limit on the amount of vacation time we pay out to, two weeks. Gary Boggess stated that he has used this kind of system before and that it works very well. He also stated paying the two weeks out would save the County a lot of money. Kealee stated that even with the change of this policy it would still be the Elected Officials duty to approve an employee's vacation time off requests. Bari Firestone stated that she was worried the employee's that have already received their vacation time now, when they started accruing vacation time on top and wondered if that would be considered "double dipping". Jill Locke stated they would still earn the vacation time until they reached the maximum amount allowed and then they would stop accruing until they used some of their time. And if we set a maximum amount of vacation time to pay out, this would allow us to budget the payout for vacation easier. Ruth Bingham asked about if each office was still allowed to have their own office policy for when an employee can use their vacation time. Kealee stated most definitely. Sabra Martin asked what would happen with employees that have been working but have not reached their oneyear mark, would they just start accruing from that point or would there be any pro-rated vacation for the time they did not receive? Charles Sifers, ADA, stated that we would have to go back and pro rate their vacation. Kealee also asked that everyone give her their ideas on how they would like to see the

vacation policy look like. Kirk Painter requested that everyone submit their ideas to the County Clerk's Office so they could get the plan wrote up and then would be put on the agenda for approval. Jill Locke suggested maybe have one more meeting on this after the ideas have been submitted and for the secretaries that handle payroll for the barns also be present so they have a better understanding on it as well.

Kealee Romero informed everyone that it will be budget time soon and the Officials need to decide what kind of raises we will be given to employees this year. A percentage raise or a matrix type raise. She gave information on the matrix raise and told how this would affect the County and the employees.

Lisa Hannah asked if the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor could be opened for viewing of records. The Commissioners decided to let the abstractors go to the 3<sup>rd</sup> floor to view records. They stated that after we get a camera system up there the public would be allowed to go up there also.

Zachary Davis made a motion to adjourn. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.
