Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on May 30, 2023

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale Thompson informed the Board on how much rain we received and stated that the Caddo Nation is picking up the bus that Grady County donated to them. Kim Duke stated that the Ninnekah appreciation dinner is on Sunday at the school. Bobby Cantu reported that there was one reportable motor vehicle accident last week. He stated that he has concluded the safety meetings and completed a new employee safety orientation.

Mr. Stewart England representing Floyd & Driver was in attendance. He stated that the Federal Government has put out a notice stating they were looking at taking back any ARPA money that had not been encumbered at this time. He said they have updated this notice to say it would not affect the County, only Federal programs. He gave the Board information on how much money is left in the ARPA fund and how much interest has been collected.

Kirk Painter spoke on wanting to split the interest money between the three districts and put the rest of the ARPA money which is \$74.94 into General Fund. The Commissioners acted on this but it will be voted on in the next meeting as an agenda item.
