Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on August 7, 2023

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 31, 2023 meeting. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Kim Duke reported that she sent out the Fire Board Minutes last week and she presented the Commissioner's the list of Fire Board Members and their terms. Bobby Cantu informed the Board about the leak that occurred in the attic last week. He stated that the galvanized water pipes in the attic are covered with asbestos, a company had to be called in to remove the asbestos before the pipe could be repaired which is why the repair took so long. He also stated that the galvanized pipes only have a life span of 50-80 years and the piece of pipe that was removed for repair was corroded. He stated that we needed to start thinking about the risk of another water line break causing the destruction of our records that are housed in the attic, especially the records that are around the pipes. In order to mitigate the threat of losing some of our records Bobby would like to see more of the records moved to the 3rd floor and then move the records away from the pipes on the attic floor, this would allow access to the water pipes so we can begin removing all of the asbestos and changing out the lines. Bobby also informed the Board that he has been in contact with CMS Willowbrook about the weight limit of the Courthouse and they are having a company come in to take a core sample of our concrete so they can get an exact weight limit. Bobby has also scheduled the 3rd Quarter safety meetings.

New Business: Sabra Martin was present, she stated that with the updating of the electric to the Sheriff's Department they were working on relocating a breaker box, when they found more out dated and hazardous wiring that will need to be replaced. She stated that she is getting 3 quotes for this to present to the Board.

Gary Bray stated that the Watermelon Festival will be held on Saturday. Sabra stated that the Sheriff's Department would be there, and Kirk stated if Gary needed use of an ATV for any of the Fire/EMS department to get in contact with Dale Thompson to use Emergency Management's ATV.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve setting the Elected Officials salaries as follows: serviceability increase for the Grady County Officials salary in the amount of \$500.00 per, year effective July 1, 2023 for all Elected Officials and making it retroactive. The Grady County Officials salary will be comprised of the following (less than allowable travel allowance): Base Salary - \$49,500.00, Serviceability - \$23,000.00, Population increase - \$687.50. For a total approved salary of \$73,187.50 with base salary respective to the Officials new terms. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Zachary Davis stated that after reviewing some of the expenditures that Emergency Management had made and the expenditures that had made at the end of the Fiscal Year, he felt that the money was not being spent properly and was in excess. He gave a list of expenditures for the other two Commissioner's to review. Zachary stated he did not feel comfortable with requesting the Sheriff to lower his budget by \$300,000.00, and not requesting a non-elected official who he felt was not spending money wisely to do the same. He stated it was the Board's responsibility to make sure County money is being spent properly and he was requesting that the Board cut the Emergency Management budget by \$30,000.00, with the understanding that if they came up short in their budget, they could come to the Commissioner's to request a supplementary transfer. This would allow the Board to decide if any extra money was needed and would have their approval. After review of the expenditures the other two Commissioner's agreed.

Zachary Davis made a motion to lower the EMPG FY 2023-2024 General Fund Budget by \$30,000.00. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the FY 2023-2024 General Fund Budget, with the budget amendment, and send it to the Excise Board for their approval. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the Transcript of Proceedings and signing of deed for the following:

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve Employee Leave Sharing. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Gary Bray made a motion to approve a lease agreement between Joe Cooper and the Grady County Sheriff's office for 6 Tahoe's. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve to transfer \$50,000.00 from the Contingency Account to the Sheriff's M&O General Fund Account to pay for the deductible for the Sheriff's office vehicles that were damaged in the hailstorm. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to deposit a check in the amount of \$28,667.68 from ACCO into the Sheriff's General Fund Account for reimbursement of the cost of damage repair from the hailstorm to sheriff vehicles. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to deposit an EFT from the US Treasury in the amount of \$50,000.00 for the second half of the Local Assistance and Tribal Consistency Fund into the LATCF Fund M&O Account. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Representatives from the nursing and pharmaceutical departments at Grady Memorial Hospital came to speak with the Board. Mary Beth Malone, CNO at Grady Memorial Hospital, informed the Board that the hospital has to be surveyed every 3 to 5 years, if the hospital does not pass this survey to make sure the hospital is up to code and performing correctly then the hospital cannot stay open. She requested assistance to hire consultants from Vizient to help prepare for the real survey, as they have already preformed a mock survey for the hospital. Vizient will help to identify problems and change policies. If time allows Vizient might preform another mock survey. She stated that she expected it to cost around \$50,000.00. Jackie McAdoo discussed with the Board about the hospital's property insurance. She stated that the hospital had to create their own insurance company, and after the first year it was formed, they had 3 major claims from McAlester, Comanche, and Grady Memorial. She stated that the hospital has a budget short fall of \$813,092.00 for the hospitals part. They would like the County's assistance to pay this to keep the hospital insured. Michael Beard was present to ask for assistance from the County to help with some regular salary until revenue starts being received, the recruitment firm search fees, the physician's sign on bonus, and moving expenses for the new physicians, Dr. Soekamto (Primary care) & Dr. Byers (Pain Mngt) in the amount of \$320,000.00. He stated that he understood that the County may not be able to do this, but any amount that they could help out would help. Zac Davis stated that he would like to review all of these requests and look at the County's Budget, as the County was also going to have to spend a large amount on needed repairs to the Courthouse. He also stated that he wanted to still re-visitc3houses.com getting the Hospital's OB up and running as he had personally had expecting mothers contact him and request that the County help the hospital get it up and ready. Zac stated that he would like the hospital to inquire with the Tribes to see if they may be willing to help get funding for the project as they have to send their expecting mothers to Comanche County currently. Kirk Painter stated that he agreed with Zac, however he would like to go ahead and fund the mock survey, then address the rest at a later date.

Kirk Painter made a motion pay for the Mock Survey for Grady Memorial Hospital in an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, with all purchase orders running through the County. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve utility/pipeline road crossing permits, waterline/fast-line permits, and driveway/tinhorn permits for District #2. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.
