

Minutes of the County Commissioners Regular meeting held on September 18, 2023

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 11, 2023 meeting. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Presentation from Ebony Cooksey and Bill Baker presented Broadband Developments in Oklahoma. Ms. Cooksey handed out brochures and wanted to let the Commissioners know that they service the rural area with high-speed internet in Grady County. She informed the Board that the State has provided funding for providers to help compete with opportunities to offer connectivity with Counties. Bill Baker CEO, owner of Nexlink spoke to the Board and told them that there are currently 4 towers in Grady County and they are working on installing 5 more towers that will complete the project for the FCC.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve of the following draw request from the Grady Memorial Hospital's sales tax accounts held with First National Bank: Request #26 – Industry Systems - VDI workstations - \$130,364.60 and Request #27 – Industry Systems - UPS Rack/Tower (Five Oaks network closet) - \$2,143.28. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director: Dale Thompson informed the Board that he would be attending the Southwest Emergency Management meeting in Marlow and the Zoom meeting with the Training Committee was cancelled last week. Kim Duke stated that the regular scheduled Fire Board meeting is Tuesday September 19, they will be discussing nominations for a new clerk. Kim informed the Board about the 32 CPR cards left and they will schedule a class for anyone who needs it. She stated that she has a computer for the new Construction Superintendent that District #4 has purchased and could be moved to another office whenever they need it. Bobby Cantu reported to the Commissioners that Able Movers completed the moving of boxes in 4 days. The 3rd floor is full and there are more records so the Court Clerk would like to speak to the Commissioners about what to do next. He informed the Board that he would be having a Safety meeting with Maintenance and the Commissioners Secretary this week.

New Business: Sheriff is needing to buy two more Tahoe's for the Sheriff department from Joe Cooper. The Sheriff gave some information on his fuel and repair expense on the Durango vehicles to the Board. He stated that Middleburg and Tuttle are signing up for SRO's and the Verden Superintendent has now contacted him and would like to talk about getting an SRO, which would make every school in the County covered.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve a Resolution Supporting Operation Green Light for Veterans and any possible application of Operation Green Light for Veterans. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve purchasing a bike rack for the Courthouse. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve the Sheriff to purchase two vehicles from Federal Surplus. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Sydney Richardson, Grady County Purchasing Agent spoke with the Commissioners about developing a procedure to upfit a vehicle going forward. Sydney stated if you know what the end result is of a vehicle you should be bidding it if over the bid limit or just use state contract. The Commissioners agreed to this procedure.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the procedures for upfitting of vehicles. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve a contract between Tuttle Public Schools and the Grady County Sheriff's Office for a School Resource Officer. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

No action on the quoted bid concrete work to add a sidewalk from the back of the Sheriff's building to the parking lot on the South side of the Sheriff's Building due to no one has gave him their quotes at this time.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve an action on a bid request for the rewiring of offices/rooms within the Sheriff Office – Offices include: Sheriff, Undersheriff, OSBI, and Conference Room. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Gary Bray made a motion to award the bid for new windows for the Sheriff Office where windows were previously removed to Sooner State Home Improvement LLC \$37,500.00, only one bidder. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve signing a letter of intent to submit an opioid abatement grant award application to the Oklahoma Opioid Abatement Board and authorizing Kirk L. Painter to sign the letter of intent on behalf of the Board. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve of the action to use the remaining \$4,540.98 LATCF Grant money for the beautification of the Courthouse project. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve to purchase the remaining tile that matches the tile used at the courthouse from McComas and Associates and store in the Emergency Management Warehouse. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve interlocal agreement between Grady County District 1 and the City of Tuttle. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the installation of road signs that prohibit Commercial trucks. The proposed signs will read "No Commercial Trucks." The location of the proposed signs and the roads affected by the new signs are located within District 1 and are more specifically described as follows: Cemetery Road (County Street 2940) ½ mile south of Highway 37 to Fox Lane (County Road 1220); and Cimmaron Road from Rock Creek (County Road 1200) to Sooner (County Road 1230). It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Kirk Painter, Gary Bray, and Zachary Davis.
