If granted, this permit is subject to the following conditions, requirements, and covenants, to wit:

1. Applications for tin horns must be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners with a bond check in the amount of \$2,000.00 made payable to the Grady County Commissioners, a copy of liability insurance and completed permit. The Applicant shall contact the County Commissioners at the completion of the crossing for an onsite inspection. Contact information: 326 W. Choctaw Chickasha, Ok 73018 * 405-224-5211
2. Entry from, or onto, any County roadway for tin horn installation for any use, whether commercial or private, shall be governed by this permit. Commercial entities shall be responsible for installation in accordance with the provisions of this permit. Diameter, placement, length, and wall thickness and material of all tin horns placed in or on public Right-of-Way(s) shall be determined by the County Commissioners (or his designee) for the district in which said encroachment occurs prior to installation.

3. Entry from County roadway for tinhorn installation for commercial use shall be governed by this permit. Installation for private citizens shall be done by: County Commissioner staff. Commercial entities shall be responsible for installation in accordance with the provisions of this permit. Diameter, placement, length and wall thickness and material of all tinhorns place in public ROW shall be determined prior to installation by the County Commissioner (or his designee) for the district in which the encroachment occurs.
4. The petitioner/contractor shall furnish all flagmen, lights, barricades, and warning signs meeting all laws and regulations, including those in the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices" appropriate for the construction project and/or signage otherwise required by ODOT. The petitioner/contractor agrees to keep the roadway open to traffic and in clean condition throughout the course of construction unless otherwise approved by the Board of County Commissioners. At the conclusion of such work, the right-of-way must be cleaned up and left in as good or better condition than upon Applicant's arrival.
5. As stated in Item #1, the petitioner/contractor shall post a performance bond in an amount set out herein or otherwise to be determined by the Board of County Commissioners. Necessity for such bond will be determined by the Board of County Commissioners and the bond will be held in the County Commissioners' office until the right-of-way is in a presentable condition. Presentable condition is to be determined by the County Commissioner (or his designee) in whose district the work is performed and will be based upon inspection of the worksite on conclusion of permitted activity.

When notified to do so by the Board of County Commissioners the petitioner/contractor agrees, at his expense, to make all changes in the County right-of-way.

Placement of tinhorns in a County right-of-way in violation of these provisions shall result in assessment of a find equal to the cost to remove the item(s) installed and return the property to its original condition or \$5,000.00.

Performance Bond

The Performance Bond required in order to secure this Permit shall be remitted to and held by the Board of County Commissioners of Grady County pursuant to the terms and conditions set out herein. Upon the right-of-way being deemed presentable, such bond/ shall be returned to the Applicant.

Request for Deviation from Permit Terms

If Applicant requests deviation from the provisions set out in this Permit, the Application shall be set on the Agenda of the Board of County Commissioners for determination whether deviation should be granted, and what fee and/or bond shall be set, if any.
