Minutes of the County Commissioners regular meeting held on June 17, 2024

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regular meeting with the following board members: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Gary Bray made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2024 regular meeting. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director/Superintendent: Dale Thompson reported that the emergency management boat was being taken for its annual servicing. He also hoped to go pick up their new Emergency Command vehicle this week. He presented the annual renewal for the SDR and Hyper Reach Systems and explained how we have been funding them. Kim Duke stated the Fire Board meeting would be tonight at 7:00 pm and gave the Commissioner's a copy of the agenda. Bobby Cantu stated they have begun moving storage from the attic to the 205 building, however the issues with the alley way they had to put a hold on moving more. He will be conducting a safety meeting with District 2 this week. He also responded to a vehicle accident last Friday and helped with traffic control. Lastly, he stated that he has been going out and removing tree limbs from in front of stop signs on County Roads. Mike McDaniels stated that VanDyke was to begin the alleyway plumbing repairs today under the skywalk between the Courthouse and Jail. He also brought to the Boards attention that the Sheriff's building has water standing in the basement. He stated that he would get another pump to help remove the water. However, from the location of the water in the basement he felt that it was ground water leaking up into the basement. He stated that he is contacting someone to do a foundation inspection on the building and would let them know the results from there.

Public Comments: None.

New Business: Gary Boggess informed the Board of 5 police vehicles they can purchase through lease and stated he would bring it before the Board later. Gary Bray discussed the need for District 3 to purchase more land to use for their yard at District 3 barn. He stated that there was 12 acres that recently came up for sale that joins the land of the barn. He also stated that they had begun the appraisal process and asked Sydney how many they needed to have. Sydney stated that they would need 3 appraisals total, then if the land was appraised for less than the asking price they would need to go to the DA for approval of the purchase.

Rodney Young was present to address the Board about unprofessional comments made in regards to the Fire Board during the last Commissioner's meeting. He stated that as far as the Sales Tax went, the Fire Board had indeed not discussed it as a Fire Board. Even though they may have known about the Sales Tax coming up for renewal individually as a Board they did not. Gary Bray requested that Rodney Young read the portion of the minutes from the June 10, 2024 meeting that pertained to the Sales Tax and Fire Board. Rodney stated that he forgot his glasses, therefore had Robin Burton read the excerpt. After it was read Gary Bray asked if they were correct. Rodney stated they were except it left out a comment made about one particular Board Member. Gary Bray stated that if Rodney was upset about the word lying that it was a synonym for several other words that meant something was not correct. As for the comment that Rodney was referring to, it was not done intentionally. Gary Boggess

stated that this should not be addressed in an open meeting. If there were issues like these, that individual needed to get a hold of the Chairman of the Board to address the issue.

Terry L. Hawkins, Jordan Smith and John Nelson were in attendance to present the Board the Ground Lease agreement for Ninnekah Schools. Zachary Davis made a motion to approve a Ground Lease agreement between Independent School District No. 51 of Grady County, Oklahoma (Ninnekah Public Schools) and the Grady County Industrial Authority and a Lease/Purchase agreement between said Authority and said school district; and containing other provisions relating thereto. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Kendall Dillon, a civil engineering company for Crafton Tull, was present to discuss how the 2005 Resolution on roads was outdated. He stated that he would like to see the Board adopt updated road section. This would not be less of a standard than it currently is, just to reflect what kind of materials are in current use. He presented the Board an example of what he and his company came up with for their current housing addition. Zachary Davis stated that he did agree that the 2005 Resolution needed to be updated, this resolution pertains to the requirements a road must meet for the County to accept a new road for county road maintenance. Gary Bray asked if it would still be up to the Board to accept the new road maintenance. Commissioner Davis stated that yes, the road maintenance would still need to be approved or disapproved with each new plat. He also stated that the idea behind the road requirement and resolution, is that you should not have to do any repairs to the road for a few years and in that time, taxes would be being collected on that new section of road. So, by the time it needed to be repaired you would have already collected the money to repair it. He also stated that he would take the example presented and get with CEC to come up with an updated version of the resolution. Gary Bray made a motion to table the agenda item for altering a 2005 Resolution that states all roads within Grady County being additions and subdivision of tracts of land shall not be accepted by County Commissioners to maintain unless roads are constructed to a minimum standard set forth (see resolution). It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Paul Jones and Phillip Clark were present to explain the water project for Grady County Rural Water District 6. Mr. Clark stated that they were having to increase the size of their water lines. He presented the Board with copies of the project and plans. Kirk Painter made a motion to approve Grady County Rural Water 6 installation of water lines within the County rights-of-way. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Gary Bray made a motion to approve Indigent Final Disposition for James W. Kirby. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

The Board acknowledged of a tort claim filed by Lena Steverson.

Kealee Romero and Sydney Richardson asked if this year for the ACCO-SIF and ACCO-SIG payments, if the Highways portion could be transferred from each department into the Highway Budget account so there would only be one check for Highway. The Board agreed that this would be fine. Zachary Davis made a motion to approve an agreement between Grady County & ACCO-SIF for the FY 2023-2024, and to make one payment in the amount of \$302,543.00. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve & execute the agreement establishing the Association of County Commissioners of Oklahoma. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve agreement between Eastern Oklahoma Youth Services & Grady County for juvenile detention services at Pittsburg County Regional Juvenile Detention Center for the 2024-2025 fiscal year. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve a contract renewal for the fiscal year 2024-2025 between Worth Hydro and Grady County for technician services. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve a maintenance agreement between Grady County District 1 and Standley Systems, LLC. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Gary Bray made a motion to approve the following FY 2024-2025 contracts for the Treasurer's Office: Quadient Leasing – for post meter, TM Consulting, Inc. – for software lease and maintenance agreement, Cummins Allison – money machine maintenance, Industry Systems – service agreement and Server & Printer Lease, Intellavault, LLC – Cloud backup, and Standley Systems – service agreement and copier lease. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the FY 2024-2025 Grady County depository banks. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the FY 2024-2025 Grady County Investment Policy. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to rescind the bid/contract with the Hazard Mitigation Specialist. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve Grady County Emergency Management along with the aid of the State to finish the Grady County Hazard Mitigation Plan. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Mike McDaniels explained that this lean-to would free up space within the storage building. He also stated that he is currently getting quotes for the addition and it is looking like it would cost around \$30,000.00. Kirk Painter made a motion to approve adding a lean-to on the Emergency Management storage building for vehicle storage. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve a quote from DePriest Interior Design in the amount of \$1,916.29 for the purchase of blinds for the Sheriff's newly installed windows and to pay for them out of the general government account to help with energy costs. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion approve a bid request for the rebidding of cover material for District 1. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to award a bid for additional Commonly Used Items for the Grady County six month bid to the lowest bidders. (See bids for pricing). It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the County hosting a blood drive July 24, 2024 from 10:30 to 1:30. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.
