## Minutes of the County Commissioners regular meeting held on August 19, 2024

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regular meeting with the following board members: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

. The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Gary Bray made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 12, 2024 regular meeting. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director/Superintendent: Dale Thompson reported that he has finished the training for the school safety kits for Alex, Tuttle, Verden, Ninnekah, and Friend. He stated that the HMP plan has been sent to FEMA for some minor changes but should be done soon. He is going to Rush Springs today to check on the repeater in that area. Kim Duke informed the Board that the agenda for the Fire Board meeting on Tuesday night is ready. She stated that she would be sending out the financials by the end of the day to them. She told them that she is getting ready for the fair this week and reported that Farwell, Acme, Bailey, & Cox City were on a big fire in Farwell last weekend. Mike McDaniels informed the Commissioners that they were finishing the lean-to tomorrow. They are waiting on the electrician to work on the Sheriff's warehouse and he is starting the sheet rock on the Sheriff's office. Bobby Cantu stated that he was at District #2 this morning performing a Safety meeting and will be going to District #1 tomorrow. He also has Safety meetings set up with the Sheriff's office, Emergency Management, and the Construction Superintendent this week. Bobby stated that he had some empty cabinets in the attic ready to move and will be doing more organizing at 205 Chickasha Avenue.

Audience Participation: Mark Keeling said for the last 4 months he has wanted the Fire Tax ballot issue looked at. He has wanted input from the Commissioners and a committee of citizens to research the Fire Sales Tax. He stated that it is a county sales tax on the citizens and he feels like we should do the right processes to get this done. He is not against the tax; he just wants it done properly. He gave the steps laid out in the OSU worksheet for how to get a tax on the ballot. He told the Board that educating the public is very important and promoting the fire tax is key. The money comes from the tax payers and he does not feel like that the Commissioners have done the research on this enough to move forward at this time and would ask them to wait until February.

New Business: Sheriff Gary Boggess was present to discuss his Public Service Announcements on the radio. He stated that Mrs. Locke got with Commissioner Davis and then sent an invoice to Charles Sifers, A.D.A. to investigate, to determine if this was a campaign ad. Sheriff Boggess stated that you could look at it and tell that it was not a campaign ad and that he also paid for this item out of his budget. He stated that he budgeted for PSAs and felt that the question on the purchase order should been directed to him and not the Commissioner or the D.A. He then gave the Board the copy of the D.A. approval for the Public Service Announcements. Mrs. Locke asked to respond to the Sheriff and the Board. She stated that as the County Clerk, her and her office are responsible for the legal expenditures for the County. She stated that she called the Auditor's office to ensure that it was a legal expenditure, and the Auditor said that it was not. She stated that the Auditor's office said that if the DA's office approved it then it would be fine. She stated from there she took it to Commissioner Davis, who then sent it to Charles. At that point Charles approved that it was a legal County

expenditure and the issue was done. Sheriff Boggess stated again if the PSA was read, you could clearly see that it was not a campaign ad. Mrs. Locke stated that she was doing her job as the County Clerk by checking legal expenditures by contacting the Auditor's office. Sheriff Boggess stated that he already spent hundreds of dollars out of his own pocket paying for County Public Service Announcements and that he was advised that he should submit reimbursements for those. Mrs. Locke stated that if the District Attorney's office authorizes it there was nothing wrong with that either.

Charles Sifers, A.D.A. addressed the Board and stated there was a road that a citizen informed him that needed repairs. Commissioner Painter told him he had spoken to the citizen and would be working on the road as soon as they can but they have other projects at this time.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve of the following draw request from the Grady Memorial Hospital's sales tax accounts held with First National Bank:

Mark Lyles on behalf of Camino Natural Resources spoke to the Board how to bid for oil and gas leases. He stated that Blaine County has done the process before and we could use their example. They approve a resolution stating what the terms of the resolution are, advertise for two weeks, and do a resolution on authorizing the execution an oil and gas lease. Then whoever showed up could bid on the lease.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve to go out for bid on Oil and Gas Lease for Grady County. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray. Later in discussion it was decided as the Board did not have anything prepared for the bid that it would be added to next week's agenda.

Commissioner Davis addressed the Fire Tax issue with saying this Fire Tax benefits over 60,000 people in Grady County. We have changed one thing on the ballot to include new fire stations if that could happen in the future. Commissioner Davis stated that we have one of the largest county fire departments and it is over one million dollars a year to fund these stations. County Highway could not fund this for them so this fire tax is very important.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve of a resolution and a proposition to allow the question of the imposition of a countywide sales tax to benefit the Fire Departments of Grady County to go to a vote of the citizens of Grady County during the November 2024 General Election. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve of signing deed and transcript of proceedings for the sale of property to Peggy Euwins: TID # 23871 - Parcel # C010-00-002-014-0-000-00; located at 927 El Reno, Chickasha, OK 73018, legal description: all of lots 14-15 Block 2 Apache Addn — Chickasha. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Acknowledgment of the termination of South-Central Workforce Lease of Suite 3 at 205 W Chickasha Avenue, Chickasha Oklahoma.

Gary Bray made a motion to approve to accept the resignation of Billy Jack Tate from Grady County Fire Board as the Acme representative. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Gary Bray made a motion to appoint Jarrod Cagle as the Acme representative to the Grady County Fire Board for a term of 5 years. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve a quote from Cooper Fleet Services for the purchase of 7 Police Tahoe's off state contract for a total amount of \$376,817.00, for the Grady County Sheriff's Department. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Kirk Painter made a motion to approve ACCO to use the county deductible account for the Assessor's vehicle that was totaled out in an accident for \$25,286.83. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Commissioner Painter asked if we could dissolve the 2005 resolution and move forward with the new resolution on how to maintain private roads. Commissioner Painter stated he would like to see the Commissioners approve these roads to be opened. Commissioner Davis stated that accepting an older constructed road will cost a lot of money to update. Commissioner Bray's concern is that when people buy property and want a road built and there is not enough room to even build a road, should we be responsible for building that. Commissioner Painter stated that he thinks it should be up to the discretion of the Board of Commissioners, of course new home development we need to follow the resolution. The Board should decide whether they have the money to build a road or not. Commissioner Painter would like to dissolve the 2005 resolution. Charles Sifers, A.D.A. stated that you cannot dissolve it, you would need to replace it with different language. The Commissioner's decided it would be best if they come with a new agenda item next week that stated what they wanted to do, but today move forward with the resolution that is on the table.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the update of the 2005 Resolution that states all roads within Grady County being additions and subdivision of tracts of land shall not be accepted by County Commissioners to maintain unless roads are constructed to a minimum standard set forth (see new resolution). It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the action on the signing of the 2024-2025 Estimate of Needs and 2023-2024 Financial Statements for Grady County. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve of utility/pipeline road crossing permits, waterline/fast-line permits, and driveway/tinhorn permits for District #2. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the Blanket Purchase Orders, #251511-251584. It was seconded by Kirk Painter. AYE: Zachary Davis, Kirk Painter, and Gary Bray.

Commissioner Bray read aloud the Purchase Orders that are being done incorrect.
