

## **Minutes of the County Commissioners regular meeting held on February 3, 2025**

The Board of the Grady County Commissioners met on this day for a regularly scheduled meeting with the following board members: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

The meeting was called to order and roll call: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

The meeting was opened with the "Pledge of Allegiance"

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 27, 2025 meeting. It was seconded by Ruth Bingham. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

GCEMA/Fire Report/Safety Director/Superintendent: Kim Duke gave the Board the run total for the 2024 of 941 runs for 2023 was 788. Kim stated that the Fire Chief meeting is tonight and the Fire Board did not have a quorum so that meeting was cancelled. She informed the Commissioners of training that she would be doing tomorrow with the Emergency Networking Reporting System. Mike McDaniels reported that the building that Dale Thompson applied for a grant with the State was approved. He stated that he would be working on getting the awning attached to the front of the building at District #2 barn removed.

Gary Bray made a motion to approve accepting the resignation of Keith Mangus as the Farwell representative to the Grady County Fire Board. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Gary Bray made a motion to approve appointing Derrick McDaniel as the Farwell representative to the Grady County Fire Board for a term of 5 years. It was seconded by Ruth Bingham. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Gary Bray made a motion to table the appointment of Chris Mosley to the Grady Memorial Hospital Advisory Board representing Grady County District 3. Commissioner Bray stated he would like to talk to the hospital about this appointment before he accepts this candidate. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Acknowledgement of Mary Green as 1st Deputy for Assessor's office.

Ruth Bingham made a motion to remove Samantha Firestone and add Shannon Wimberly as requisitioning officer on Assessor and Visual Inspection. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Ruth Bingham made a motion to remove Shannon Wimberly and add Mary Green as receiving officer on Assessor and Visual Inspection. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Ruth Bingham made a motion to approve a contract between Grady County and Apprentice. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Ruth Bingham made a motion to approve Veterans Exemption for 2024. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Mark Lykes with Camino was present and asked for the Board to proceed with an auction for the County's Oil and Gas leases. Commissioner Bingham stated she had done some research on this item and found that she would like to do an auction, but would like to change the minimum on the bid. Mr. Lykes stated that the County can change the minimum to a quarter and when the auction begins change the minimum on the bonus as well. Mr. Lykes stated that he would get all 3 advertisements ready for the County to put in the paper. The winning bidder would pay the County for the advertising after the auction is over.

Ruth Bingham made a motion to approve of a tabled item for a presentation by Mark Lykes with Camino on Oil and Gas lease offers. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Ruth Bingham made a motion to approve a tabled item for Charity account and setting up the following parameters for helping the homeless with food and water during extreme weather conditions. The County will provide \$100.00 per day as needed to the following facilities that have commercial kitchens. Life Skills - overnight stay must be 25 degrees or below and the Soup Kitchen is open during the day for 32 degrees or below. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Zachary Davis made a motion to approve an agreement between Grady County and Locke 2012 Revocable Trust (Patricia Locke), for storing District 1 heavy equipment. It was seconded by Gary Bray. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Sheriff Boggess stated that after doing some research on the rifles he felt there are some safety concerns and warranty issues with the suppressors and would like for the Commissioners to reject the bids so he can have some time to do more research. Commissioner Bingham expressed her appreciation for the bidder out of Lawton for taking the time to do research and explaining to the Commissioners about the safety concerns of the suppressors when he turned in his bid.

**Zachary Davis made a motion to reject all bids for custom built AR-15 rifles for Grady County Sheriff Office due to safety concerns and warranty issues. It was seconded by Ruth Bingham. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.**

Commissioner Bingham had questions on the deductible that the County uses for wrecked vehicles within the County. Commissioner Davis stated that after attending an ACCO SIG/SIF meeting where they were informing the counties of all the claims, we need to look at different ways to help with the County's vehicle claims. Commissioner Davis wanted to put it on the agenda to set up a policy for a new procedure on how to handle these claims in the future.

Gary Bray made a motion to approve depositing a check from ACCO in the amount of \$10,994.36 into the Sheriff Service M&O account for repairs on unit #2307 & #2404. It was seconded by Zachary Davis. AYE: Gary Bray, Zachary Davis, and Ruth Bingham.

Commissioner Bingham would like to see if we could start keeping the cars that has been surplised instead of giving them away to other entities outside the County. Commissioner Bingham stated that if we sold them in auction, we could use that money to help with fixing some of the cars that we have had claims on in the past. The Sheriff stated that he was donating the cars outside the County to departments that don't have as many resources. This shows the public that the County is helping out other departments; as well as, and that department may have resources that we need in the future.
